THE ODERBRUCH PEOPLE MAKING LANDSCAPE

Ever since the drainages that were started in the 18th century under the Prussian crown, the Oderbruch has developed into one of Europe's most interesting micro-landscapes. This region, the largest settled polder in Germany, was the first cultural landscape ever to receive the European Heritage Label in 2022.

Local history parlours and village museums, churches, pumping stations, ship lifts and windmills – these sites, all designated under the label, make the landscape and its heritage tangible, and their diversity is what makes the Oderbruch so fascinating. All forty-four of them are presented as a miniature exhibition in the Oderbruch Museum Altranft.

This booklet introduces the Oderbruch's heritage sites one by one and in detail. The accompanying side notes provide additional recommendations for cultural and culinary stops. Not all of the locations have fixed opening hours. Some are accessible to the public, while others are run by private individuals who must be contacted in advance. The side notes therefore include up-to-date contact data for each location. The Niederfinow ship lift, inaugurated in 1934, is the oldest of its kind still in operation in Germany. However, a new and larger lift has commenced operations alongside it in 2022. Both of them, as well as the four-step lock and the Lieper lock with the adjacent Finow Canal, are testimony to 400 years of hydraulic engineering history at the edge of the Oderbruch. Over a hundred thousand visitors come to see the enormous ship lift every year. Once you are there, you can take one of various guided tours that are on offer. This is Brandenburg's oldest museum of technology. The focus of its exhibitions and large museum park is on inland shipping in the Oder region. The museum also provides general tourist information and is otherwise an ideal place for the planning of further excursions. An industrial heritage trail stretches alongside the Finowkanal, the oldest artificial waterway in Germany.



You can continue your journey by canoe after renting from Kanuverleih Oderberg, or you can travel as a passenger on one of Fahrgastschifffahrt Oderberg's ships.

The Heimatstube Hohensaaten explores the traces of the fishing, shipping and agriculture trades that once characterised the village. Approaching from the south, the lock systems "Ostschleuse" and "Westschleuse" are impressive landmarks. This is where the Wriezener Alte Oder connects with the modern "Stromoder" branch. In the town centre, visitors will find the restored church, built in Neo-Gothic style according to the plans of the Royal Master Builder August Stüler. After a bike ride of five kilometres north along the Oder, you reach the Unteres Odertal National Park.

A visit to the Altglietzen ring kiln brings the history and traditions of the brickmaking craft back to life. Today the ring kiln is a technical monument. The support association offers guided tours that provide comprehensive insight into the craft of brickmaking and the unique design of the well-preserved facility. A special highlight is the brickmakers' festival, which takes place every year in June.

You have to look very carefully to see the orb on the church steeple. The welded metal sphere contains old documents pertaining to the church, which was built in 1770 as a colonist church on royal land. On the square south of the church is the tomb of Louis Henri Fontane, father of Theodor Fontane. From here you can enjoy the wonderful views across the Oderbruch. In addition to services, each year the church hosts the event series »Zur schönen Kirche« ("At the Beautiful Church"), which features choir concerts, readings and theatre performances.

The exhibition in the small half-timbered house at the entrance to the village of Schiffmühle is shaped by memories of Louis Henri Fontane, father of the poet Theodor Fontane. It also teaches visitors about the history of the village of Schiffmühle, from its founding in the 18th century until the end of East Germany as a country. The small museum with adjoining café and water playground also invites guests to spend time in the garden. In nearby Bralitz you can book a raft tour on the Alte Oder with Odertours.

PUMPING STATION

The flood pumping station in Neutornow, built in 1895, was converted to electrical operations in 1968. With its brick-faced masonry, it reflects the architecture of building period and is regarded an important technical and historical landmark to flood protection in the Oderbruch. The adjoining residential building of the master pumping station operators provides a striking impression of how the station once worked. Additional flood pumping stations for the Oderbruch can be found in Bad Freienwalde on the Freienwalder Landgraben, opposite the train station, and in Liepe.

The idyllic Malche Valley is a place where people can find relaxation for body, mind and soul. In a Bible house founded in 1898, women were prepared for missionary and deaconry work in the Orient. After 1945, the Malche became a training centre for community education for the Protestant Church.

The Malche now serves as a guest and conference centre with a diverse annual programme. The signposted tour explains the history of the historical site. A large old orchard and the adjacent stream and meadows lead you to nearby hiking trails and lookout towers.

of Nature Conservation) is a museum dedicated to the particular philosophy and worldview of Kurt Kretschmann (1914–2007) and his wife Erna (1912–2001). It is surrounded by a show and educational garden highlighting various landscape and garden types. Children and adolescents can take part in a wide range of environmental education activities. From here you can set out on wonderful hikes in the Bad Freienwalde area or visit the Rathsdorf Stork Tower – a former brick kiln between Bad Freienwalde and Wriezen that gives information about the habitat and behaviour of the white stork.

Bad Freienwalde is the oldest spa and bath resort in Mark Brandenburg, and the Oderlandmuseum is Brandenburg's oldest regional museum. Its permanent exhibition shows in broad terms how the Oderbruch was drained and highlights the history of Bad Freienwalde as an official resort. Altranft is the showcase of the Oderbruch and its unique waterways network, its inhabitants and distinct rural culture. The exhibition tour begins in Schloss Altranft, a manor house in the middle of a 19th-century landscaped park. The special topography of the Oderbruch is presented by Antje Scholz in her web installation that represents the water routes of the Oder and the over 1000-kilometre system of irrigation ditches. A large marble track allows visitors to playfully explore the course of the waters. Photos of inhabitants of the Oderbruch, films and audio installations appeal to all senses.

The bridge between Neurüdnitz and Siekierki has been a long-standing traffic route and, at a length of 860 metres, was declared a technological monument in 2005. In 2022, it was reopened as a cross-border bicycle and footpath. A viewing platform reveals impressive outlooks on the riverine scenery around. To take a rest, there are numerous seating arrangements with information boards on the history of the bridge and the special flora and fauna along the Oder.

The "Lietze" settlement is the oldest colonist village in the Oderbruch. Today, the half-timbered houses are protected as historical monuments. A signposted tour of the village informs visitors about the life of the colonists, and each September, the whole village hosts a Colonists' Day. This year's OderBuch series of reading events is fully dedicated to the topic of German-Polish encounter. Event dates can be found at klub-der-kolonisten-neulietzegöricke.de. The Theater am Rand ("Theatre on the Edge") in Zollbrücke is very close by. Here, directly on the Oder, you will find further places to stop for refreshments.

In 1789, farming families from Altwustrow built their own church without royal consent. From the outside, the half-timbered building looks rather modest. Inside the church, visitors can admire the baroque pews and pulpit altar as well as a paper ceiling unique in all of northern Germany. Each year, the church and the attractive village ensemble draw scores of visitors to the former fishing village. If you find the church closed, please contact Klaus Schröder, who will be glad to open the doors and offer you a tour. There is also a circular footpath to the neighbouring village of Neulietzegöricke and ten information boards with interesting facts about both villages.

Altwriezen is one of four old fishing villages in the northern Oderbruch. The half-timbered church was once the village landmark. However, it was demolished in 1973 because the congregation lacked the resources to repair it. A support association is now raising money to rebuild it, beginning with the spire and bell. You can find more information about this project on the organisation's website. From May to September, the Ersatzkirche, or substitute church, is open every first Sunday of the month from 2 to 5 pm. Serving coffee and homemade cake, the association invites you to stop by for a visit and chat.

Prior to the drainage of the area in the middle of the 18th century, Wriezen was the uncontested capital of the Oderbruch. Goods were shipped from this port to Silesia and Pomerania, Poland and all of Prussia. The taxes from fish sales and barge traffic filled the city coffers. Historic buildings at the former port, such as the lime kiln, a manufacturer's villa, the port warehouse and the dairy still serve as prominent reminders of this chapter of the city's history.

Wriezen is one of the few proper towns of the Oderbruch and is perhaps the location most closely linked to the history of this unique landscape. The tower of Marienkirche, its oldest building, is a widely visible landmark for the inhabitants of the Oderbruch. The destroyed parts of the church are currently under restoration. Located directly in front of the church is a market fountain created by the sculptor Horst Engelhardt (1951–2014). The partly provocative statements inscribed on it have sparked some discussion in the area and beyond.

The exhibition introduces the very influential Prussian agricultural reformer Albrecht Daniel Thaer (1752–1828), who ran a model farm in Möglin, where he researched, experimented with and documented the principles of efficient agriculture. His work had a direct impact on the agricultural development of the Oderbruch. Opposite the exhibition building you will find the 400-year-old mansion where Albrecht Thaer lived and the park with his burial site as well as a bust from the year 1978.

The Bliesdorf local history parlour gives you a fascinating insight into rural life in the Oderbruch. The collection of tools, household appliances and everyday objects is the work of passionate collector Vera Schröder. A single visit will not suffice to fully appreciate the extent of this cabinet of wonders. A visit to the village church in Bliesdorf is also highly recommended. It is considered a typical example of a late-19th-century village church designed in the tradition of the regional brick Gothic style of the Mark Brandenburg.

The Chamisso Museum is dedicated to the German-French poet, naturalist and world traveller Adelbert von Chamisso (1781–1838). In the summer of 1813, he was a guest at the former Kunersdorf Castle, where he wrote the fairy-tale novella "Peter Schlemihls wundersame Geschichte", which is considered a work of world literature to this day. Between 1815 and 1818 he embarked on a three-year trip around the world. His biography is inspiring and also unique. In the vicinity of the museum are the Kunersdorf church and the Cemetery Colonnade, a family burial vault for local nobility and significant work of art even on a European scale.

A large sculpture of the river god Viadrus stands in the floodplain near Güstebieser Loose, bidding welcome and farewell to travellers crossing the river on the German-Polish ferry. It is the work of sculptor Horst Engelhardt (1951-2014) and stands here as a symbol of the new European Oder. "Vivat Viadrus!"



By taking the short ferry ride, visitors can continue their excursion on the Polish side of the river. The landscape park near Cedynia offers wonderful vantage points over the Oder valley, and a museum in Gozdowice provides information about the operations of the Polish and Russian armies in the spring of 1945.

An Allee is a tree-lined road in the tradition of French Baroque landscaping, and the Neubarnim Lindenallee is the landmark of the colonist village, which was built between 1754 and 1756 and is strictly aligned with its high road, a settlement layout called Angerdorf. It is the longest avenue of linden trees in all of Brandenburg. The Lindenfest festival, which takes place during the summer, enjoys popularity well beyond the village itself.



The road takes you past two double-storey halftimbered houses that are listed as historical monuments, as well as one of the last so-called "quarrel houses", semi-detached buildings in which quarrels are said to have frequently broken out in the common sooted "black kitchen".

Neutrebbin is the largest colonist town in the Oderbruch. To mark the 200th anniversary of the Kingdom of Prussia, a bronze statue in honour of King Friedrich II (1712–1786) was erected here in 1904. In the 18th century, the king, whose nickname later became "Alter Fritz", had started to drain the former swamplands in order to gain fertile farming ground. Two more statues of him are located in Letschin and Neuhardenberg.

Altfriedland is located on a strip of land between the lakes Klostersee and Kietzer See and numerous fish ponds, with a lot of things to discover: a monastery and church, an ancient manor house, a swimming spot, plants and animals as part of the Märkische Schweiz Nature Reserve and the Langes Haus (long house), a former manor workers' accommodation, with its herbary and local history parlour. The exhibition presents selected exhibits related to twelve places and their local lore. Life in the village culminates in a festival on the first weekend in August and concerts in the refectory on the monastery grounds.

The school and prayer house was built in 1764 as an elongated half-timber building in the village centre. It once housed the school, the church and accommodation for the teacher and also, initially, the community shepherd, all under the same roof.



After several extensions in the 19th century and the addition of a spire, the church interior assumed its current spacious form with the installation of a Mickley organ.

Not far from Wuschewier you can visit the Altfriedland monastery complex. The Klostersee and its adjacent sunbathing lawn invites visitors to swim in the summer.



Karl Friedrich Schinkel's "Molkenhaus", a reconstruction of Solomon's Temple, is considered the first Neo-Romanesque building in continental Europe. It is made of unplastered bog ore, the typical sediment of the Oderbruch. The "very peculiar ensemble", designed by Friedrich Gilly and embedded in the fields of the Quilitz Manor of Neuhardenberg as a pleasure ground, is unique in the history of landscaping. The exhibition "Der junge Schinkel 1800–1803" about young Karl Friedrich Schinkel explains how the building came into existence and how dairy farming was part of a poly-centric agricultural system in the Oderbruch.

In the early hours of 31 January 1945, Red Army troops crossed the Oder and formed the first bridgehead on the territory of today's Germany. Three months later, the Second World War was over. In 1970, a memorial site was established to commemorate the occasion. Since then, a Russian T-34 tank has been standing in the town centre. The monument ensemble in Kienitz, which provides information on the events of both world wars, also includes the First World War (1914–1918) monument, the monument "To the Victims of 1939–1945" as well as a memorial stele at the location of the bridgehead by the Oder.

The volunteer fire brigade is an essential part of the village. Not only does it fight fires and other threats, it also fosters a bond within the community. The fire engine house was built prior to the hose tower, which dates from 1012. In addition to housing firefighting equipment, it also served as the local prison. In 1938, Paul Bettge, a member of the district council, was imprisoned here for not voting for the NSDAP in the Reichstag elections. A street in town is now named after him. Delicious rolls and pastries are offered in the traditional bakery nearby.

Simon's Park and Farm Grounds in Seelow were a well-known destination at the beginning of the 20th century. In 1919, a Berlin-based banker named Hugo Simon bought the Schweizerhaus, a tourist restaurant, with all of its associated buildings, and converted the complex into an agricultural model estate. Simon was also a social democrat, pacifist, temporary finance minister and a patron of the arts, and he used the location to accommodate friends and guests from politics, art and culture until he was forced to flee from the National Socialists in 1933. The "Schweizerhaus Seelow" local history association offers guided tours, and an exhibition shows the life of Hugo Simon.

The tower houses the burial place of Konrad von Burgsdorff (1595–1652), a prominent military man and politician of his time. His ceremonial coffin is on display in the Neues Museum in Berlin. The steeple platform provides sweeping views of the Oderbruch – an ideal starting point for further excursions. Details are available on the information board in front of the church.

The Klessin manor, sitting elevated on the Reitwein crest, was a strategically important location for the German Wehrmacht in the spring of 1945. It commanded views on five Oder bridges about two kilometres away and among the Wehrmacht's outposts on the Oder front, it was the one most fiercely and longest fought over. After several weeks of battle, the manor and the villages of Wuhden and Klessin were almost completely destroyed. Today's memorial site commemorates the dreadful events and their victims with an installation of multilingual information boards and audio columns and a symbolic replica of the entrance portal to the manor.

The small town of Lebus rests in an idyllic landscape of hills and meadows ten kilometres to the north of Frankfurt (Oder). From the Burgberg hill, you can enjoy sweeping panoramic views along the Oder and far into the Polish countryside. In spring, the banks of the Oder attract thousands of visitors with their unique populations of pheasant's eye flowers (Adonis vernalis). At Haus Lebuser Land, visitors can explore the history of the town and region. In addition to permanent and special exhibitions, the association offers lectures, reading groups and field trips. A look into the programme is worthwhile at any time of the year.



The Oderbruch shows what the future for rural areas in Europe might look like. From a historical perspective, it is a cultural landscape shaped by the most advanced civil engineering know-how of the 18th century. It exemplifies humans' appropriation of nature on a large scale, a tedious yet sustainable process which involved optimising the water regime of a whole region over ten generations, through times of war and political change, and making it more ecologically sound over time. Due to immigration from many parts of Europe, the Oderbruch is a particularly diverse landscape today – a Little Europe, one might say. Considering these prominent features, the Oderbruch was awarded the European Heritage Label in 2022.



Each of the Oderbruch's heritage sites depends on committed people to tell the stories of their places and their lives in a rural area. To support the sites, the Stiftung Oderbruch (Oderbruch Foundation) collects donations, which can be made to the following bank account:
